Are you searching some international experience? Would you like to work in a multicultural team and develop your teamwork skills?

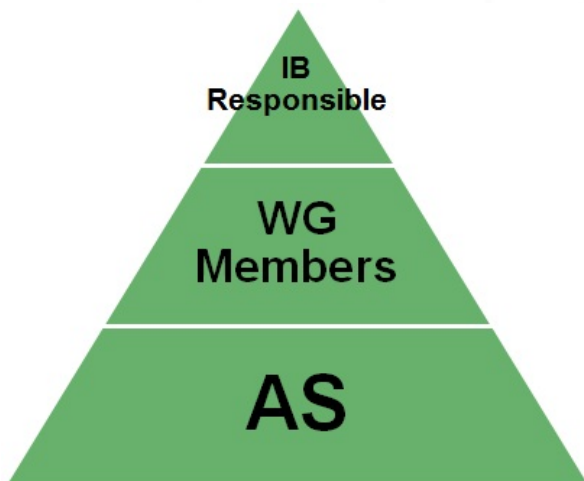
Then, this is the right time for you! The international Working Groups are recruiting members to face their new challenging and exciting projects for the upcoming year.

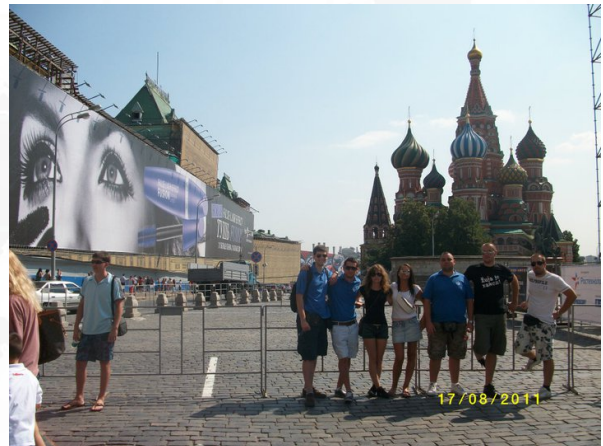

Greetings everyone! Here is the report from AS Zagreb and our great trip to Russia!

Due to our tradition, our educational journey FSB-X, this year had a goal of visiting one of the largest air shows in the world, MAKS airshow in Russia, which was held 16th-21st August at Zhukovsky airfield near Moscow. In ,already, fourth consecutive journey FSB-X 2011 was

attended by 30 students and two professors. After much thought and in accordance with the financial possibilities, we decided to travel by train from Zagreb to Moscow for a long two days. The first day we spent sightseeing museums (Polytechnic Museum, the Central Museum of the modern history of Russia) and the city's attractions (Kremlin, Bolshoi Theatre ...). The next day we headed by bus in the Monino museum which is 50 kilometers away from Moscow. Monino Museum is one of the largest aviation museum in the world and our guide was a former pilot whose plane was also on display at the museum. In the early morning hours of 19.8. we went to the town of Zhukovsky, to MAKS Airshow. The first few hours, we inspected the Russian military aircraft with the lectures of professor Milan Vrdoljak Ph.D. professor Ivica Smojver Ph.D., and Captain Daniel Vukovic from the MOD. We had a chance to see and learn about Kamov helicopters . In the afternoon hours we had an independent tour and a chance to enjoy the flight program. On 20.8.,we went to The Memorial Museum of Astronautics. We were there for a few hours and saw unique exhibits from the wealthy Russian space history. It was time to get back to Croatia, and after all, we can say that Moscow has acted very encouraging to us. FSB-X 2011 fulfilled it's mission, and now it's time to get new ideas and think about the next FSB-X for the following year!
